INTRODUCTION

The sport of golf began in the United States in the later part of the 19th Century. By 1900 all states with the exception of Idaho had golfing facilities. Interest in the game has grown rapidly from these early years of development. Within the last 25 years golf has become quite popular. Participation in the sport by well known public personalities and the exposure provided by television coverage during this recent quarter century were important factors in this popularization of golf.^{1/}

The development of golfing facilities in Alabama followed this same general pattern with many courses opening in the last 25 years. Both a private and public sector evolved within the State's golf industry to attempt to satisfy the growing demand. Several different subgroups developed within each stratum.

Private Sector

Most of the courses within this group depended solely on private financial institutions to provide funds for initial capital investments. However, the source of operating capital for facilities varied greatly among courses. Management's decision concerning the type of membership established at the facility was an integral factor in determining the amount and/or availability of revenue.

Some of these privately built clubs made the facilities available to members only. The number of members, therefore, was very important in the financial management of these clubs. After an initial membership or

entrance fee, supplemental revenue for ordinary operations was obtained through a monthly assessment. This entitled all members of the immediate family use of the available facilities. Often an additional fee was charged to the golfers on a per round of play basis.

Similar to the above type was a subgroup which allowed guests of members to utilize the club's facilities. The guests were usually charged a per round fee to use the golf course, however, members may or may not have been levied a similar fee. Operating capital for clubs came from members, usually by the same provisions as in the members only subgroup.

If the membership of either of these types of facilities was sufficiently large, expansion or any new facilities could be financed strictly by membership assessment, thus avoiding conventional lending agencies.

Another subgroup within the private sector of Alabama's golf industry implemented some innovative approaches in course development. The planning of new subdivisions by real estate developers began to include golfing facilities. The subdivision promoters financed the initial construction of the golf course, and following sale of lots the ownership of the property was transferred to the subdivision aggregate. Membership may have been open to people not living in the subdivision, depending upon the management decisions of the new owners. Operating expenditures were appropriated by methods similar to those used by the types of clubs previously discussed.

Alabama had a few golf courses in the private sector which were built by business firms. The facilities' capital sources were included as part of the firms' regular financial structure. Membership was similar to the types previously discussed, i.e., restricted to employees only or open to guests of employees as well. One firm's golf course was open to the public. Public play did not interfere with the demand of the employees. Since this

was the only golf course located in that particular county, a worthwhile service was provided to the local citizens.

Included, within the private ownership sector was a group of golf courses open to the public. Most of these were built by entrepreneurs who recognized a high demand for golf facilities existed and decided to provide the service desired. Several of the courses represented substantial capital investments. In addition the operation and maintenance of the course required relatively large amounts of money. Therefore, it was most important to these owners that profits and a reasonable return on the initial investment be realized. Generally, these businesses used the per round fee system to collect revenue. Other methods included daily or monthly fees.

Finally, an intermediate subsector was observed, which was called semi-public golf facilities. Membership fees were levied which entitled these golfers certain privileges, i.e., the course was open to the public only during certain time periods. Usually, days which were known to have higher demands were reserved for members and/or their guests depending upon the policy at the particular club. The financial management of these courses was basically the same as a members and guests type course.

Public Sector

The facilities in Alabama developed by the public sector were dependent solely on some governmental institution for financial assistance. Municipal or state programs provided the necessary capital for the initial construction phase and for all operating expenses thereafter. Management was essentially the same for municipal and state owned golfing facilities. Most frequently the charge to play on these courses was on a per round basis.

However, often annual fees, monthly fees, and/or daily fees were available. These "members" had no special privileges.

Generally, most of the municipal courses were located within the larger population centers of the State. These courses were often in association with other outdoor recreational facilities provided by the city for its citizens. These other facilities may have been areas for participation sports, or simply parks or gardens.

Several golf courses have been built recently by the State of Alabama as a part of its park development program. Golfing facilities were included in the revamping of the existing parks in Baldwin, Lauderdale, Marshall, and Shelby counties. Golf courses were also included at the new parks that were built in Barbour and Wilcox counties.

Problem and Objectives

Prior to this study a complete inventory of golf courses per se was not available. Golf courses were included in other studies, but only as parts of comprehensive projects which were more general in nature. Reports from these projects provided the starting point for this survey. These basic data were improved to include those changes that occurred during the time differential existing between the prior studies and this one. Finally, all golf courses in Alabama were incorporated and a data base for this specific area of outdoor recreation was established for the State.

This directory should provide much needed information to the various subsectors of Alabama's golf industry. A location analysis of golf courses in the State should be helpful to both in-state and out-of-state golfers, and to various suppliers of golf related equipment and the other necessary inputs for golfing facilities. In addition this type of data will be

extremely useful to both public and private recreational planners as they determine the kind of outdoor recreational facilities needed to meet the population's demand. The data base that has been established will be updated periodically so that it will be as useful in the future as it is now.

Method of Study

The supply inventory was conducted as an iterative process. Initial lists of golf courses were acquired from the 1970 Alabama Statewide Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan, the National Golf Foundation, and the Alabama Cooperative Extension Service. Duplications were eliminated and a preliminary composite list for each Alabama county was compiled. The composite list was submitted to extension personnel in each county for additions and/or deletions of courses. A mailout questionnaire was sent to each manager of golf courses on the adjusted list. A followup questionnaire was sent to each non respondent. Each course on the adjusted list was visited by interviewers who verified data from the mailout questionnaire and obtained additional information regarding course operation. Each manager was queried regarding the location of other golf courses in the vicinity. By checkbacks and cross-checking, an inventory of all existing, proposed, and recently closed golf courses was obtained.

Supply of Golf in Alabama

The number of courses exceeded the number of sites due to the presence of distinctly separate courses within one facility. A site with 27 holes of golf, for instance, had a conventional 18-hole and a 9-hole par-3 course. In a few cases courses within the same facility were physically separated with individual clubhouses. Thirteen courses were identified that were closed during 1974 or in immediately preceding years. Five courses were

under construction and several additional courses were in the planning stage in 1974. During the interview period 192 courses at 188 facilities were identified, as shown below:

The number of courses and total number of holes are constantly changing as new courses are built and existing courses add additional holes for play. The list of golf courses indicates the various additions underway at existing courses.

Golf Courses Construction in Alabama

Golf facilities were constructed in Alabama prior to 1900, however, many of the earlier courses are no longer in operation. Only four of the facilities in operation during 1974 were constructed prior to 1913, Table 1. The largest increase in golf facilities occurred during the period 1964-74 when 59 percent of the courses open to public play and 43 percent of the courses for members only and members and guests were built. During the period 1964-74 the number of public and private facilities constructed was almost equal. However, during 1974 only one of the courses under construction was for public play. The golf courses were listed by the initial year of construction.

In many cases additions were made to the course in subsequent years. Expansion of a 9-hole to an 18-hole course or the addition of a new 9- or 18-hole course at existing facilities occurs continuously. For example,

Twin Lakes Country Club in Marshall County was constructed in 1965 and 9 additional holes were added in 1969. The same expansion occurred on many other courses as golf demand increased.

The 192 golf courses in Alabama in 1974 were relatively evenly divided between 9- and 18-hole facilities with a few 27- and 36-hole facilities. The separation between courses available for public use and private facilities was more distinct. Among these courses, 84 were 9-hole and 93 were 18-hole. Of the 9-hole courses, however, only 23 percent were open to the public, Table 2.

In general, 27 percent of the golf courses in Alabama in operation in 1974 were open to the public. Of the five courses under construction only one was a public course, however, with the opening of a new private facility in Lee County one of the existing private 18-hole courses will become a public municipal course.

The amount of play on any course is influenced by numerous factors, however, public courses in general normally sustain greater demands. Private courses can limit play to members and control course use by regulating the number of golfing members in the club. The pattern of play did not remain constant for Alabama courses. Approximately the same proportion of public and private courses were overplayed, Table 3. Somewhat surprisingly, a higher proportion of public courses were underplayed.

A second factor influencing the participation at a golf course is location. An urban course, whether public or private, has a larger population base from which customers can be attracted. Using the census definition of urban, 150 of the existing golf courses were in urban areas. Thus 78 percent of the golf courses were in areas containing 58 percent of the population. Only 19 percent of the public courses were located in rural areas, Table 4.

The disparity between rural and urban public courses would be even greater except for the State Park courses constructed during the last few

years. On a population basis and converting courses to 18-hole equivalents, rural residents have one golf course per 45,900 people while urban residents have one course for every 16,600. Although each rural golf course serves a relatively large number of residents, these people do utilize facilities located in nearby urban areas. In addition some urban residents may travel to rural areas for golfing, so a trade off does exist.

Alabama's Golfing Facilities

The actual location of each golfing facility within Alabama's 12 planning and development districts is given in Figure 1. Each facility is classified according to the number of holes with exception of the Par-3 category. No distinction was made regarding the number of holes for these facilities on the map. Table 4 summarizes the map, giving the total number of courses by size on a district basis.

The directory which follows Table 4 provides much more detail about each course. The listing is alphabetized within each county with the counties sorted in alphabetical order. The majority of the courses were either 9 or 18 holes. Therefore, in order to maintain as much efficiency as possible in processing the data, those facilities with more than 18 holes were listed more than once. This was the reason the sum of golf courses was greater than the total number of golfing facilities in Alabama. The complete mailing address is given for each course followed by a location and comments column. In this column a brief descriptive location is given for those courses whose location was not easily determined by the mailing address. Since space on the page was a limiting factor here, other comments included in this column were only those thought to be the most helpful to the reader. After this column is given the number of holes and yardage per course. The last item

for each course in the directory differentiates between those that are Par-3 facilities and the conventional facilities which have variable par.

The listing following the main directory gives only the name and membership classification of each course within each county. The alphabetical order is the same as for the main directory. The membership categories were discussed in a previous section and are as follows: (1) members only, (2) members and guests, (3) public, and (4) semi-public.

Every effort to obtain as complete information as possible was made throughout the entire study. However, the dynamic nature of this industry will require updating of the data continuously. 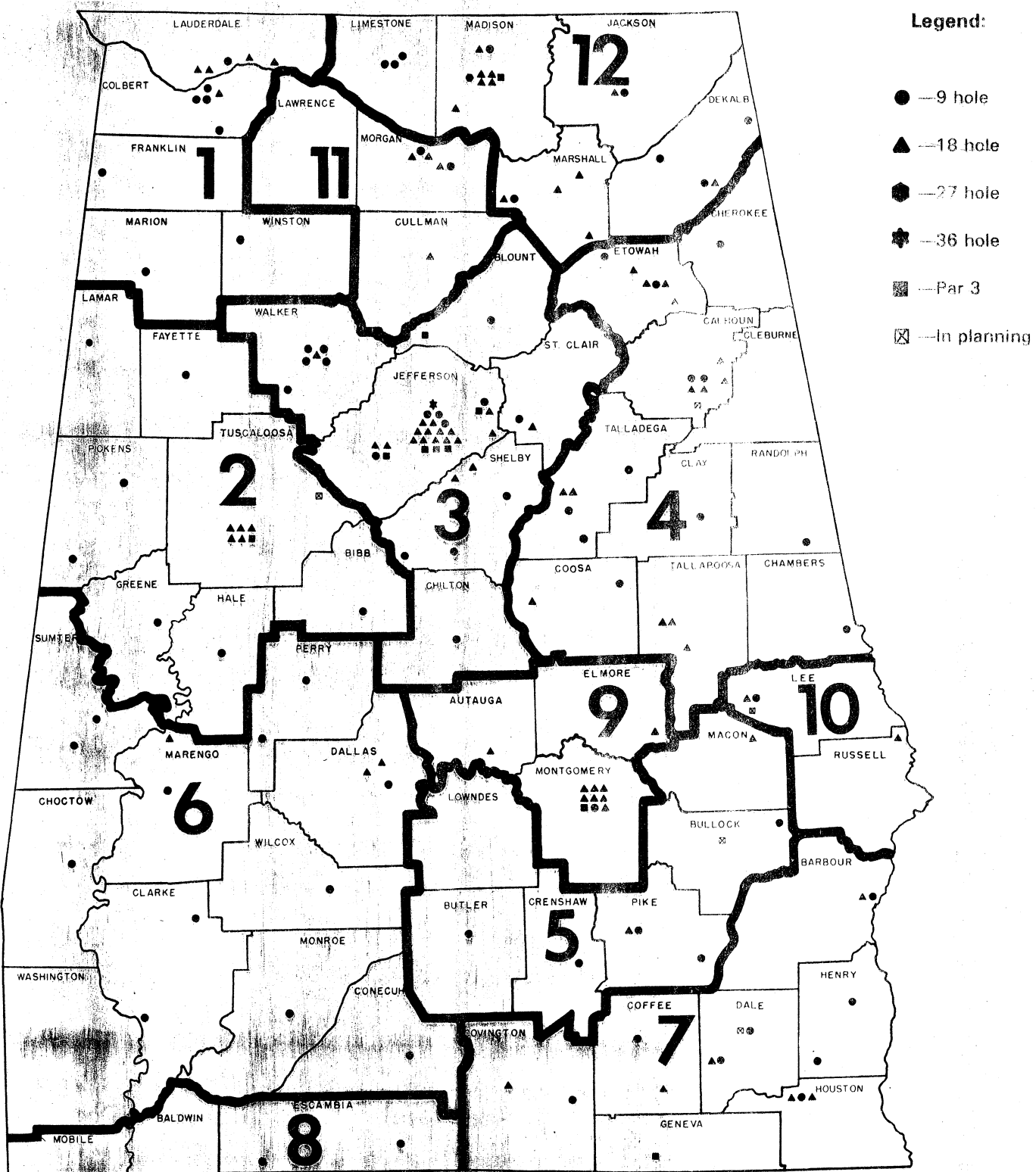
